INTAKE PROCEDURE

When a referral is made to CORE Treatment Services, Inc. for a potential client to receive services, a pre-screen will be completed and the individual will be given information to have a medical clearance completed by a physician. Financial information will be gathered at that time. An appointment will be made as soon as possible, with clinical staff, for intake.

A counselor will meet with the potential client and will complete the following:

- □ Withdrawal screening
- □ ASAM Placement Criteria
- Initial Assessment
- □ Consent for Treatment Form
- □ Preliminary Service/Treatment plan
- □ Explanation of assessment and service/treatment plan
- □ Communicable Disease information, risk factors and referral
- □ Release of information forms

Upon acceptance into the treatment program, the residential staff will complete the following:

- Resident Rights
- Medication review
- □ House rules and expectations
- □ Search of belongings
- □ Bed bug protocol
- Drug test
- □ Tour of facility
- □ Room Assignment
